

How to Register on the EDEN Portal


- 1. Open the site www.edenireland.ie
- 2. Click the 'Continue to access EDEN' button.




3. Click on the 'Sign up now' link.




- 4. Enter your email address.
- 5. Click the Send verification code button.




- 6. Switch to your mail client to retrieve the verification code.
- 7. Enter the verification code.
- 8. Click the 'Verify code' button.




- 9. Enter your password.
- 10. Confirm your password.
- 11. Enter your first name and surname in the display name field.
- 12. Accept the EPA Privacy and Terms of Use.
- 13. Click the Create button.




14. Select your preferred secure authentication method, ie email or authenticator app.



- 15. Click the Continue button.
- 16. Click the Send verification code button.




- 17. Switch to your email client and copy the verification code.
- 18. Enter your verification code.
- 19. Click the Verify Code button.




20. Click the Continue button.



- 21. Select an organisation type, ie private organisation, local authority or national organisation.
- 22. Enter/select the organisation name in the search field. For private organisations, if the organisation is not found, the option 'Click to create new' is displayed, proceed to step 23 otherwise skip to step 25.



- 23. Click on the option 'Click to create new'.
- 24. Update Organisation details.
- 25. Click the 'Next Page' button.
- 26. Enter you own contact details on Step 2.



- 27. Click the 'Next Page' button.
- 28. Select a module you require access to on Step 3. Please note, access to other modules can be requested when your portal access has been approved.
- 29. Click the Submit button.
